SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

The competition will be held under the **General Competition Rules of Motorcycling Australia** and these **Supplementary Regulations** apply and any final instructions:

1. **LICENCE:** Current Motorcycling Australia licence plus proof of current Club Membership e.g. Card Receipt etc. Day Licences are available on the day.

2. **TIMES:** Scrutineering: 7.30 - 8.30am Briefing: 9am
Practise at 9.15 am

3. **ENTRY FEES:** Pre Paid Entries

Seniors: \$15

Juniors: \$10

Extra Classes: \$5.00 junior and senior

Club has introduced pre paid entries to expedite the signing in process on race days. As an incentive. A pre paid entry is cheaper than entering on the day. Pre paid entries must be posted to Race Secretary, 329 Newbed Road, Railton, 7305 - 5 days prior to race day. Refunds are at the discretion of the CMXC Committee.

Senior: \$20.00

Junior: \$15.00

Extra class Fee: Senior \$10.00 Junior \$5.00

4. **FLAG MARSHALLS:** **ALL RIDERS MUST SUPPLY A FLAG MARSHALL.**

Flag positions will be allocated and advised at sign on race day. ALL riders must supply a flag marshall. No exceptions.

5. **MACHINES:** (Number. plate colours) and clothing must conform to GCR's and MTAS Bi -laws. Machines, licence clothing, helmet, boots must be presented at scrutineering. Log Books to be presented at scrutineering by both Juniors and Seniors.

6. **BACK NUMBERS:** ALL COMPETITORS must wear a corresponding number on their back & be presented at scrutineering.

7. **CHANGE OF MACHINE:** Will be permitted only if the Clerk of Course, Steward and Lap scorers are notified prior to the event, numbers must be changed.

8. DRUG TESTING: All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA drug education program drug testing may take place at this event in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency. If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors telephone the Drugs in Sports Hotline 1800 020506. Random Breath Testing may take place at anytime. **THE READING IS .000**

9. DOGS: NO dogs are permitted at any MTas sanctioned event. Any dog must be removed from the complex, except if a guide dog.

10. THE CLUB/PROMOTER: Reserves the right to cancel, postpone, or abandon and races may be added, altered or deleted by the club in consultation with the steward/s.

11. FUEL: As per G.C.R.'s

12. EXTRA MOTOS: If a class exceeds one full grid, extra motos will be run over 15 minutes.

13. CODE OF CONDUCT: Any person (rider, spectator, mechanic, official, etc) attending any Motorcycling Tasmania meeting must abide by the code of conduct as per the G.C.R.'s. Penalties apply for those who do not abide by the code.
