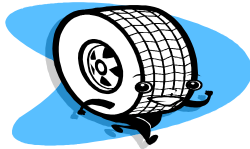

If I don't get some soon, I will have to resort to ringing mums and getting a few baby shots and some special 'stories', so get in before this happens!!

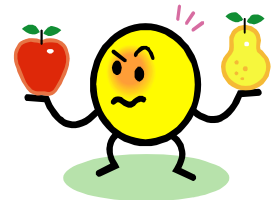
COMPETITION NEWS
